



Madison Cloud Library

General Information

Madison Cloud Library allows you to browse and read or listen to books from your mobile device or your personal computer. Much like looking for books at the library, you can search for books by separating out different formats, available items only, and title, author, or subject – while at home or on the go!

You can browse the Madison Cloud Library catalog while in the 3M Cloud Library app or by visiting the Library Catalog at: <http://catalog.mainlib.org/> and selecting Madison Public Library from the drop-down menu at the top-right corner.

Items available with the 3M Cloud Library app will have this icon next to them:



Up to 3 titles can be checked out at a time.

These titles remain on your account for the full loan period and will automatically be returned when the loan period has expired. By selecting “Return” in the “MyBooks” tab an item, items can be returned earlier in order to check-out more items.

All eBooks and eAudiobooks are checked out for a 14-day loan period.

You can place up to 5 titles total on hold at a time – which is any combination of eAudiobooks and eBooks. To receive email notifications for when your holds are available visit the Settings tab in the 3M Cloud Library app, enter your email address, and respond to the verification email that is sent.

Items cannot be renewed. If you place a hold, please have less than 3 3M items out at a time so that you will be able to check out the held item when you are notified of its availability.

Note: You will need your **library card number** and your **PIN** to use the Madison Cloud Library. Your barcode number can be found on the back of your library card. Your PIN is normally set to the last 4 digits of your phone number.

Compatible Devices

Setting Up the 3M Cloud Library App

Installing the free 3M Cloud Library app varies from device to device.

- **Apple, Android, and Nook** device users can visit their app store or storefront and search for “3M Cloud Library”, and then select the app to download and install. Once in the 3M Library

app, they will be prompted to select **NJ > Madison Public Library >** and to enter their library card number and their PIN.

- **PC and Mac Laptop** users can install the 3M Cloud Library application by visiting this website > <http://www.3m.com/us/library/eBook/howitworks.html>

and selecting the appropriate program to install for their device. Once the app is downloaded and installed, an icon will appear on their desktop and they will be prompted to enter NJ > Madison Public Library”, and to enter their library card number and their pin number.

- **Kindle Fire HDX** users will need to adjust the settings in their device before downloading the 3M Cloud Library app. Please visit this website for step-by-step instructions:
